ANNUAL REPORT
OF THE
TRUSTEES
OF THE
NEW YORK SOCIETY LIBRARY.

The Trustees of the New York Society Library respectfully submit to the Shareholders a brief statement of its affairs and condition to the close of the fiscal year ending March 31st, 1892.

From the report of the Treasurer, herewith submitted, it will be seen that the receipts from all sources, including the balance brought over from last year, amounted to \$16,443.44, and the disbursements (including the sums transferred to capital account) to \$13,713.89, leaving a balance on hand of \$2,729.55. Of this amount the sum of \$1,498.49 is the balance remaining of the income of the "Green Fund," \$219.22 being available for the purchase of works on art for the "Green Alcove," and \$1,279.27 for the purchase and binding of books for circulation except prose fiction.

The "John C. Green Fund" remains invested as heretofore in the property on the corner of Park Row and Worth St., and produces a net income of \$2,500.00 per annum. In the lot and building adjoining on the South about \$15,000.00 were invested at the same time, producing a net income of \$2,200.00 per annum.

During the past year the "Commutation Fund," \$1,275.00, and other surplus income, amounting in all to \$4,000.00, have been invested in Bond and Mortgage on real estate at 5%.

The amount expended for books was \$3,059.32 and the number of volumes added 1,410.

Most of the older duplicates have been sold in a single lot to a bookseller, a better price having been obtained for them than could have been realized at auction sale. There are now ready for sale about 400 volumes of the newer duplicates, chiefly biographies, travels, and the better class of novels.

The room on the lower floor used heretofore as a Ladies' room has been

rented to the tenant of the front room, and a new Ladies' room has been fitted up on the North side of the hall, the Library securing thereby an increase of income.

The number of members availing themselves of the privileges of the Reading Room and Library during the past year has not varied from that of the preceding year. Nor can any material increase of members be expected until the institution moves to a suitable point further up town. No such move can be made until the Library receives large gifts from some quarter.

REGULATIONS.

LOANING OF BOOKS.

Members not indebted for Annual Payments, Fines, etc., may take out any *work*, if it consists of not more than one folio, or one quarto, or three octavo, or six duodecimo volumes.

Folios may be kept six weeks, quartos three weeks, octavos two weeks, duodecimos one week.

Members residing more than ten miles from the Library are allowed one week longer. A book may be again taken out, unless another member has applied for it.

FINES.—*One cent per volume* must be paid for each day they are retained over the time allowed. Loss or damage of books must be paid; if a part of a set the value of the entire set must be paid for.

No Member can *lend* any book belonging to the Library.
